General Requirements
(Based on Sport and Exercise - Metropolitan Melbourne)

Outdoor Training Only	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Community sport training is outdoors only as indoor facilities including changerooms and covered batting tunnels remain closed. Participants can only go inside to use the toilets.
Limited Numbers Permitted at Outdoor Training	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Limited return to training is for the minimum required only, with up to 20 people, including necessary coaches or administration staff. Two groups of 20 people can train on the same baseball field if they remain separated for the entire training session.
La Trobe Sport Require Double Vaccination for all persons over the age of 16	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The La Trobe Sport COVIDSafe Plan requires that all persons over the age of 16 on the Campus Grounds of La Trobe University Bundoora must be double vaccinated. (Refer Map 1 for the area Preston Baseball Club is responsible for controlling via QR Code Check-In). This requirement will be reviewed by La Trobe Sport in the week commencing 25 October. The double vaccination requirement differs to Baseball Victoria and the current Victorian Government requirements under which vaccination status is not required at this stage, meaning participants can attend regardless of if they are vaccinated. This is not the case for Preston Baseball Club in accordance with the requirements of the Clubs landlord La Trobe Sport. To enter the area within the red line (Map 1) you must be double vaccinated at this time.
Masks must continue to be worn	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Masks must continue to be worn at all times indoors and outdoors. Masks do not need to be worn when exercising if you are out of breath or puffing
Social Distancing of 1.5m must be maintained	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Volunteers and participants and spectators must maintain a distance of 1.5m apart as much as possible. Full contact training will recommence, where they may be instances where players are closer than 1.5m, however all discussions, off field activity must be conducted with social distancing.
Density Limit enter	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> No more than one volunteers/ participants per four square meters of enclosed space is permitted. This includes the toilets, batting cage and containers where baseball equipment is stored. No other indoor spaces are permitted to be used under this COVIDSafe Plan.
Equipment	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Equipment must not be shared, including gloves, helmets, and bats.
Hygiene	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Hand Sanitizer is to be used prior to entering the red line (Map 1) and at frequent intervals while training. Sanitizer stations are located within the red line.
QR Code Check-In	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> To enter the area within the red line (Map 1) which includes the toilets and baseball diamond, all volunteers and players must Check-In at the single Check-In Point marked on the map. If over the age of 16 only person identified as being Double Vaccinated at the point of Check-In may enter the facility.
Registration to Train Mandatory (Record Keeping)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Prior to attending the first training sessions all volunteers and players must register with Baseball Victoria to Return to Train. https://baseballvictoria.com.au/vsbl-return-to-training/
Registration per Session Mandatory (Record Keeping)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Prior to attending each training session volunteers and players must register via the Events Section of the Club Team App so that limits per session can be managed by the Club.
