## President's Report

Like all other Community Sporting Clubs, the Preston Pirates Baseball Club (Club) relies upon members of our community to volunteer experience and time to ensure the Club can operate.

Upon the retirement of several long-standing Committee members a predominately new Board was elected at the last Annual General Meeting held in July 2021.

In an environment where it is more challenging than ever to attract volunteers, I take this opportunity to thank the members of the Board for volunteering and secondly for the many hours spent committed to building a long-term sustainable future for the Club and the delivery of baseball programs in the 2021-2022 Victorian Summer Baseball League Season (VSBL). Thank you, Alan Sutherland, Brian Sinfield, Kirsty Davis, Michael O'Brien, Sinead Byrne-Connell, Nicole Lynch, Vinnie Sayed and Brendon Cox.

Thank you also to the coaches, team managers, grounds crew and canteen helpers who also volunteered time and experience during the season.

Th Club has experienced declining membership numbers and revenues over recent years due to many factors and in this environment the Board identified key priorities for the season.

### **Key Priority 1 - Negotiate with La Trobe University Sport and Bread and Butta Catering the right to operate a canteen from the Club Rooms. - Achieved**

After a number of years of no or limited canteen operations the canteen culture of the club had declined with limited sales from within the club. This slowly increased over the season, with steady sales from a number of visiting teams and revenue from other events on the football oval when the club was the only canteen open.

When visiting a Club always remember to stop and buy something from the Club's canteen this is a major revenue source for Clubs so don't forget to stop buy the Clubs canteen when playing at home.



Revenue from Canteen sales increased along with an improved club atmosphere and sense of community.

## Key Priority 2. Secure a Limited Liquor Licence - Achieved

This was achieved with the licence in place for the start of the season generating increased revenue from the Canteen.
