* At the Special General Meeting held 2 June 2022 the Club Consultation was amended by the Members introducing two-year terms for Directors. The transitional arrangements stipulated that certain Director roles were taken to have commenced a two year term at the 2021 AGM and the remainder will stand for election at the 2023 AGM and commence two years terms.





President's Report

After a number of years of challenges due to ongoing construction at La Trobe University which progressively eroded many aspects of the community sporting club environment crucial to Preston Pirates Baseball Club and then the impacts of COVID which many sports including baseball are yet to experience a post COVID bounce back, the 2022/2023 Season has once again been a challenging year for the Preston Pirates Baseball Club.

At the end of the 2021/2022 Summer Season due to the construction of the new Sporting Precinct for Football Federation Victoria, the Matilda's and Rugby Victoria our Club was relocated from our home of the past twenty years at La Trobe University.

To accommodate La Trobe University Baseball Club and Preston Pirates Baseball Club, La Trobe University struck an agreement with the Victorian Department of Education and Charles La Trobe College to manage a parcel of land between La Trobe University and Charles La Trobe College on Kingsbury Drive and build a new multi-purpose baseball diamond and football (soccer) pitch.

Construction of the new baseball diamond and club rooms finally commenced in June 2022 and then subsequently experienced a number of further delays. It became clear in the lead up to the start of the 2022/2023 Summer Season that Preston Pirates Baseball Club would be homeless due to these ongoing construction delays unless it made alternative arrangements.

The Club had been developing a plan to work closely with the North Coburg Rebels Baseball Club and with no other diamonds available further developed with the North Coburg Rebels Baseball Club a plan to trial a partnership between the two clubs which would include Preston Pirates Baseball Club being able to use Parker Reserve and the Club Rooms as a home for the 2022/2023 Summer Season.

I take this opportunity on behalf of the Preston Pirates Baseball Club to thank the North Coburg Rebels Baseball Club Committee and Members for allowing our Club to base at Parker Reserves and for spirit in which we were able to partner and work together for the Summer Season.

This was never intended to be or was it a merger. While both Clubs combined teams, players continued to register for either Club and play in the Clubs Uniform.

Post the season the Committee of the North Coburg Rebels Baseball Club sought feedback from its member as did the Board of Preston Pirates Baseball Club and while the overall view was that the partnership had worked well no overriding reason existed to take the partnership further, with each Club happy to review again in the future.

President's Report Continued

Thank You Rebels



While the Community of the Preston Pirates Baseball Club should continue to be very grateful to the North Coburg Rebels Baseball Club for letting our Club share Parker Reserve this significantly limited the ability to secure sponsorship and canteen revenue.

While this was offset in a saving of lease costs to La Trobe University, no compensation has been paid by La Trobe University and on the back of declining Membership numbers in previous years the overall surplus declined by \$3k from \$6k in 2021/2022 to \$3k in 2022/2023.

Revenue declined by \$23k with a decline in expenses of \$20K compared to the previous year.

In this environment Cash held over the past three years has increased from \$10K in 2020/2021 to \$20k in 2021/2022 to \$22k in 2022/2023 a \$12k improvement.

President's Report Continued

A New Home – A New Opportunity – A New Beginning



Our new home is ready and has been used by La Trobe University Baseball Club throughout the 2023 Winter Season.

The Club will have exclusive access to the Club rooms between October – April and exclusive access of the Baseball Diamond during the following hours and use of the Lower Fields near the old baseball diamond on Sunday mornings for Junior games.

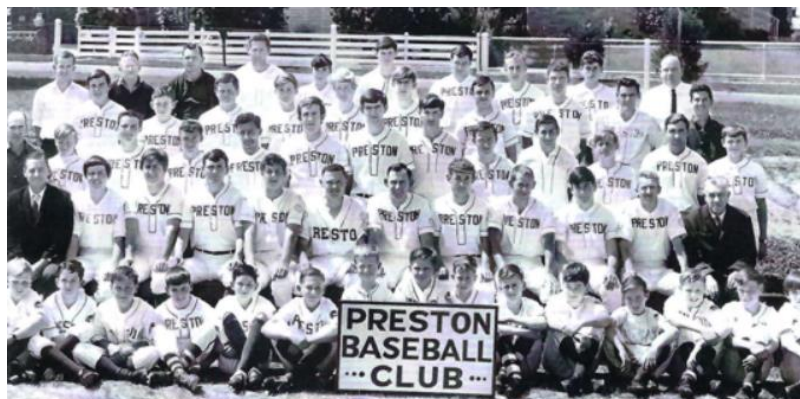

Jean was a proficient cricketer and probably, through that sporting interest, married Ron Fowler who played baseball at Preston in the 1950's. His father, Lisle, was President from 1954 to 1962.

The sporting genes continued on through a son Graham ("Chooka"), who was successful in both cricket and baseball, being one of the first Under-14's to play at Preston in 1961. Jean supported the club as canteen manager and also scorer for juniors in the morning and the first IX in the afternoon. Jean had a very strict interpretation of the rules of scoring. To get a safe hit with Jean scoring, you really had to earn it and if you dropped a foul fly, that was an error – as per the rules.

Unfortunately, Jean died relatively early, in her forties and to honour her contributions to the club, a memorial trophy was inaugurated, to be presented annually for the best junior clubperson. Any inspection of the PBC honour board will reveal some noticeable recipients of this award, which is a fitting tribute to the memory of a fine person.

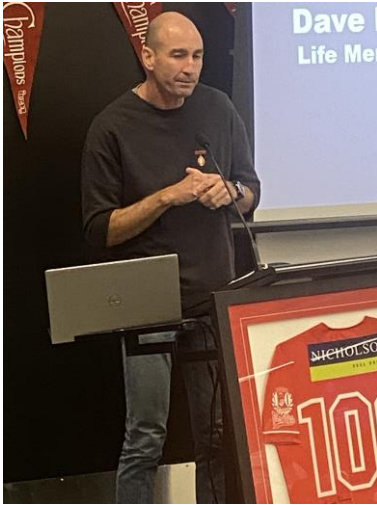

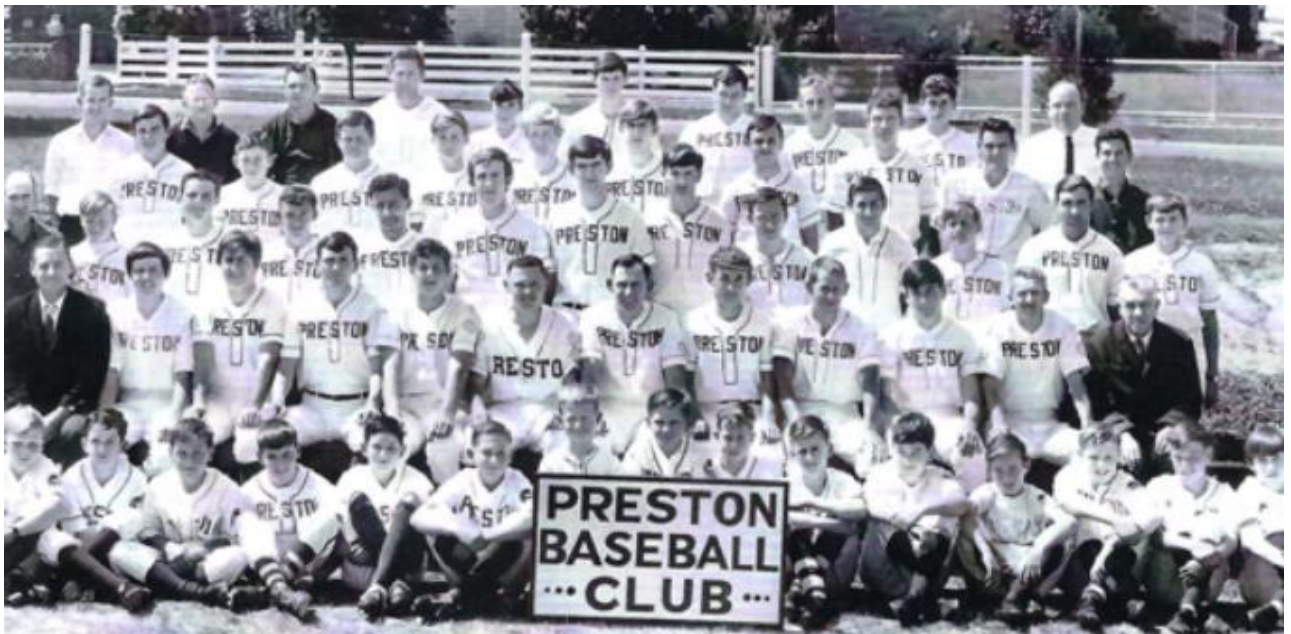

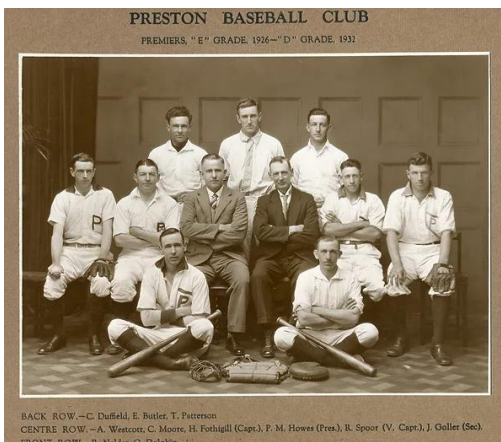
